FACTS:

- 75,000+ people in Montgomery County are food insecure
- 29,000+ are children
- Only 51% of food insecure people are eligible for programs such as SNAP, WIC or free lunch

WHAT WE PROVIDE:

- Food (\$50 provides food for a family of four once per month)
- Clothing
- Backpacks and school supplies
- Holiday meals and gifts
- Gas cards
- Financial assistance and snacks for summer camp

YOUR DONATION PROVIDES:

- \$1,250 provides food for 25 families (100 people)
- \$5,000 provides backpacks and supplies for 100 children to attend school well-equipped
- \$15,000 provides food for 50 families for 6 months
- \$45,000 provides food for 75 families for a year
